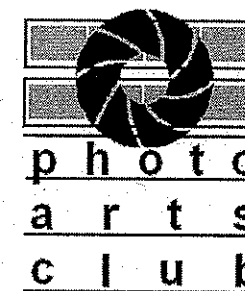

Prizes and ribbons are awarded to Best of Show and for first, second, third and honorable mention in all categories. A peoples' choice will also be awarded on May 2nd.

Rules

1. There will be prizes and ribbons awarded in all categories for first, second, third and honorable mentions and best of show
2. Entry fee is \$5 per photo, or \$4 each if more than four entries. There is no limit on entries. Make check payable to "Photo Arts Club of Toledo" and enclose in an envelope with registration information, taped to the back of one of the photos.
3. Tape the photo label to the back of each photo in the Top Center.
4. Entry size including mat, if any: minimum overall size accepted is 80 square inches (compares to an 8x10 photo). Maximum overall size accepted is 480 square inches (compares to a 20x24 photo). No frames, protective wraps or glass will be accepted.
All photos must be mounted on photo mounting board. Unmounted photos will not be accepted.
5. No nudes or offensive photographs.
6. Winning photos from previous Photo Arts Club annual contests are not eligible to enter.
7. This contest is open to amateur photographers who earn less than 51% of their income from photography.
8. Utmost care will be taken in handling and displaying photos, however the Photo Arts Club and sponsors will not be liable for lost or damaged photos.
9. No name, title or date is to be on the front of the photos. An ID label will be

attached to identify the photographer and title after judging.

10. The Photo Arts Club of Toledo has the right to use all photos for informational and promotional purposes with photographer credit.

11. A photo may be entered in only one category.
